REVIVE: To revive is to invite God to awaken and energize our soul for His mission in Christ. Revival brings spiritual vitality and a renewed commitment to live for Jesus.

Scripture Focus:

- 1) "Will You not revive us again, that Your people may rejoice in You?" (Psalm 85:6)
- 2) "But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth." (Acts 1:8)

Prayer Prompts:

- 1) Pray for personal revival—a renewed hunger for Christ and His kingdom.
 - 2) Intercede for revival in our family, church, and community, centered on the Gospel of Jesus.
 - 3) Ask God to empower us with His Spirit to live boldly for Christ and share His love with others.

Reflection Questions:

- 1) What does it mean for us to revere Christ in our daily life? Are there areas where reverence is lacking?
- 2) In what ways do we need Christ's renewal? How is He calling us to surrender or change?
- 3) Where do we sense a need for revival, either personally or in our surroundings? How can we actively participate in Christ's work in these areas?
