



Thursday: Bible Verse
“Wait for the LORD; be strong and take heart and wait for the LORD.”
Psalm 27:14

Form two groups. Face each other. First group repeats each “wait for the LORD” part. Other group repeats the “be strong” part and the reference. Repeat several times; then trade assignments and repeat some more!



Big Idea
I can trust God’s perfect timing.



Monday: Check It Out!

Check out John 6:1–15; 7:1–52. Jesus waited for the right time. When have you had to wait for the right time?



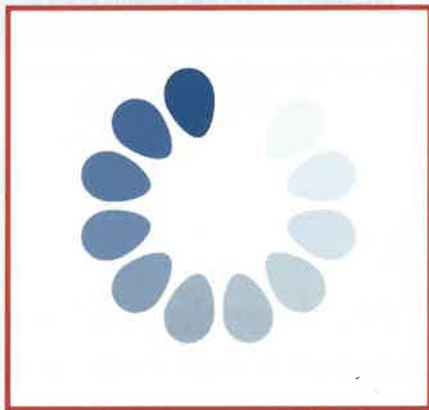
Friday: Bible Bit

Read Ephesians 4:1–2. What are times it’s hard to be humble, gentle or patient in your family? Today, list those “triggers,” and pray through that list together!



Tuesday: Bible Bit

Read Psalm 27:1, 14. David often chose to trust God and wait for Him. Today, list some ways to help each other “be strong and take heart” while you wait.



Wednesday: Bible Bit

Read Psalm 40:1–3. What did God do here when David waited? Parents, tell about times God has helped you like this—and thank God together!



Saturday: Just for Fun

Waiting doesn’t seem like something fun to do, but here’s an idea: Play Hide-and-Seek together! Who waited longest to be found? Who was “It”? How long did he or she wait before finding someone?

When we see a loading icon, we know we have to wait—and there are times when it is hard to wait! I’m glad I can ask God’s help to keep me calm while I wait. His timing is perfect. I can trust Him to help me!

Connecting to Jesus

Jesus knew that the leaders in Jerusalem wanted to kill Him. And Jesus also knew that He would die on the cross to take the punishment for the sins of the world. But it was not time yet. He could trust God’s perfect timing. Jesus was confident in God’s plan. We can be confident, too. We can trust God our Father, and His love for us, no matter what happens!
