Tuesday: Bible Bit

Read Psalm 119:66, 68. Name a command God made. What do we do when we believe in His commands? Thank God today for His Word!



Wednesday: Bible Bit

Read Mark 4:1. How did people learn from Jesus? (His words were not in books yet!) Today, take time to listen well to a Bible story!



Saturday: Just for Fun

How many highlighters lurk in your drawers and bins? Hold a five-minute hunt for them! Then test them all to see which ones don’t work anymore.
